



To be considered a War Time Veteran
The Veteran needs to have served at least one day during a Period of War with the minimum service for that period.

PERIODS OF WAR FOR THIS BENEFIT	MINIMUM ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE
WORLD WAR II • Dec. 7, 1941 thru Dec. 31, 1946	Min 90 days active service
KOREAN WAR • June 27, 1950 thru January 31, 1955	Min 90 days active service
VIETNAM WAR • From Feb. 28, 1961 thru Aug. 4, 1964 – only if “in-country” of Vietnam • August 5, 1964, and ending on May 7, 1975 – No matter where in the world you served	Min 90 days active service
PERSIAN GULF WAR • August 2, 1990, through date to be prescribed by Presidential proclamation or law	Min 2 years active service or period of service, whichever is shorter

NOTE: For National Guard or Reservists to be considered Wartime Veterans for this pension they must have been called up active for OTHER than Active Duty Training and served minimum days as listed above.
